<p>The Blessed Trinity The three divine Persons in one God; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.</p>	<p>What is Grace? Any gift of God, especially God's divine life in our soul; sanctifying grace.</p>
<p>Mortal Sin A serious offense against God's laws which kills the life of Christ, sanctifying grace, in us.</p>	<p>Venial Sin An offense against the laws of God which is not so serious as mortal sin. It lessens God's grace in the soul, but does not drive it completely out as does mortal sin.</p>
