

FEAST OF ST. ANTHONY FREQUENTLY ASKED RIDE QUESTIONS

Q: Can I redeem paper tickets that I have left over from last year?

A: Yes, but this is the last Feast that paper tickets will be redeemed. Paper tickets can be redeemed directly at rides, no need to go to a ticket kiosk.

Q: How much do ride tickets cost during the presale?

A: 30 tickets for \$32 (this includes a \$2 convenience fee) = \$1.06 per ticket

Q: How much do tickets cost at the Feast?

A: 4 tickets for \$10 = \$2.50 per ticket

9 tickets for \$20 = \$2.22 per ticket

20 tickets for \$40 = \$2.00 per ticket

26 tickets for \$50 = \$1.92 per ticket

33 tickets for \$60 = \$1.81 per ticket

48 tickets for \$80 = \$1.66 per ticket

65 tickets for \$100 = \$1.53 per ticket

Q: If I buy presale ride tickets, do I still have to activate them at the ticket kiosk?

A: No, you can use a code on your phone or print out your code and go right to the rides.

Q: What are the height restrictions on rides?

A: Because of maintenance schedules and unanticipated mechanical issues, we won't know exactly which rides will be at our event until the week of the Feast. Typically, our Feast has 9-11 rides, split evenly between "kiddie" rides and "major" rides. There are typically 1 or 2 kiddie rides with a minimum height requirement of 32", other "kiddie" rides require children under 36" to ride with an adult. Q: How many tickets are needed for rides?

A: Kiddie rides cost 2 tickets; major rides cost 3 tickets.
